Introduction

The HPC annual monitoring cycle involves two types of monitoring submissions (audit and declaration). Education providers have been divided into group A and group B. In 2008, all programmes that are in group A need to complete a declaration form. Education providers are expected to submit the monitoring submissions to HPC within 28 days of their institution's own internal annual monitoring process.

All declarations forms for programmes have been checked and confirmed by the executive. Declaration forms may be seen upon request.
