### Concerns about an approved programme's ongoing adherence the standards of education and training investigated under the programmes concerns process

<b>Decision</b>
The Panel agreed to resolve the concerns process for concern CON00081, as there is no case to answer.
<b>Reasons</b>
In making its assessment of no case to answer, the Panel concluded that no evidence had been presented to indicate there was an ongoing risk to the programme's compliance with the standards of education and training, as the programme had closed, and no learners remained enrolled.  The Panel considered that the issues raised in the concern did not impact on the ongoing compliance with the standards of education and training of other HCPC approved programmes run by the Provider.

\*Panel member Penny Joyce did not take part in the discussion or decision making process as she had declared an interest, being that she had previously been employed by the Education Provider. The remaining Panel members agreed it was appropriate that Penny did not take part in the discussion for this reason.
